Jack Bloor Fell Race 9th May 2023 – Race Report

Once again the sun shone for the 36th Jack Bloor Race. This 8.4 km navigational fell race takes place on Ilkley Moor each year to commemorate the life of an acclaimed Yorkshire sportsman and to raise funds to support young Yorkshire people to develop physical and technical skills in outdoor adventure sport.

First home this year was Nathan Lawson from Dark Peak in a time of 39:52 with Graham Rush from Leeds City AC hot on his heels in 39:54. Harry Kingston from North Leeds Fell Runners took third place. The Arthur Dolphin Trophy for the first man U23 was awarded to Jack Walton of Doss AC who was closely followed by two further MU23s, local lad Sam Bentham from Ilkley Harriers, and Max Bloor, Jack Bloor's grandson, who was competing for the second time. Alistair Richardson (another grandson, who flew in from New Zealand and competed for the first time)

Jenny Roberts from North Leeds Fell Runners led the females field home in a time of 52:52, followed by Lucy Piling (WV40) in 2nd place and Niamh Jackson (WV40) in third position. The Pat Bloor trophy for the first female U23 was awarded to Sarah Barker from Leeds University.

In the older veteran classes Aileen Baldwin from Stainland Lions RC won the LV70 category in an impressive time of 73:35.

The winning men's team was Doss AC formed of Jack Walton, Evan Bates and Ritchie Walton. For the women team event victory went to North Leeds Fell Runners Jenny Roberts, Niamh Jackson and Sarah Bannister.

Over 50 participants took part in the junior races earlier in the evening with impressive times and some close finishes, in particular the U11s race. In the U9 category Jack Luca from Keighley and Craven AC was first boy and Annabel Raven from Wharfedale Harriers first girl. The U11s was led by Jake Milner from Keighley and Craven AC and Penny Pinker-Hull, Bingley AC for the girls. For the U13s Robert Carter from Ilkley Harriers led the boys home, and Alice White from Keighley and Craven the girls. In the U15s Jacob Palmer from Skyrac was first boy and Holly Fitch from Wharfedale first girl home. Finally, in the U19s Alex Wolfenden took a clear lead for the males and Betsy Willis from Wharfedale was first female home.
